Many wartime veterans and their spouses are not aware they may qualify for extra monthly income from the Department of Veterans Affairs, a benefit known as the VA Aid and Attendance Pension.

If you or your spouse is in need of assisted or supportive living services and you believe you may be eligible, call 1-800-827-1000 to find the VA regional office nearest you.

A VA representative will help guide you through the process to determine if you qualify.
